#### 23/154 **ITEMS INTRODUCED BY MEMBERS (if any)**

The Clerk reported that Councillor Johnson had asked him to raise concerns that he and some parishioners had about activity at Old Parkside Farm. He had requested the Clerk to seek from the Planning Department more information about planning application 23/01312/FUL, and whether the site was designated a farm or an industrial site. The Clerk reported he had been informed that planning application 23/01312/FUL had been returned as it was now deemed to be a matter for Lancashire County Council. Parish Councillors asked the Clerk to email the Planning Department expressing a general concern about the site, on behalf of some parishioners. It appeared that Old Clerk Parkside Farm was being used mainly for industrial purposes for which it assumed not to have permission and that confirmation was required that this is under investigation by the Planning Department. He was also asked to make the Planning Department aware that the Parish Council had already had to register a complaint with Environmental Health regarding foul dense black smoke coming from the premises on 5th November 2023. The fire was no ordinary Guy Fawkes night bonfire but rather the burning of what could only have been assumed to be industrial waste.

The Clerk reported that Councillor Alexander had asked if the Parish Council would fund a tree guard for the tree planted to commemorate the King's Coronation. The Council approved expenditure on such a tree guard up to the value of the remaining budget set aside for the planting of a commemorative tree. Councillor Whittaker offered to investigate possible options and costs.
